Criteria for Guest Family at Captain Joseph House (CJHF)

A "Home Away from Home" for Families of the Fallen, those military men and women who have paid the ultimate sacrifice since September 11, 2001. Captain Joseph House (CJH) provides a unique service, providing an expense paid 5-night, 6-day respite/retreat in the scenic Pacific Northwest for military families from throughout the country and have lost a loved one. The House offers families a private, comfortable haven to heal, create new relationships, make new memories, and rebuild family traditions without their loved one.

1. This is an expense paid 5-night, 6-day respite for the immediate family of the Fallen. (airfare, three meals daily, snacks, family sleeping rooms, and recreational activities for all ages and based on seasonal availability, souvenirs and incidental purchases are the Families costs). Families gather in the kitchen and assist with staff to prepare meals. Transportation will be provided for the duration of the trip, including to and from Captain Joseph House.
2. Immediate Family may include spouse, children, siblings, mother, father (natural, step, in-laws), friend (may be considered as critical support for a family when there are no immediate family members).
3. The House accommodates up to three families (total of 16 individuals) based on number in each family. Apolinar Room (8-9), Blasjo Room (6-7) and Braxton Room (5-6)
4. CJHF reserves the right to make the determination of immediate family composition and number based on space availability and dates requested for respite/retreat.
5. The Fallen
 - a. Service Men and Women/All branches of the U.S. Military
 1. Army
 2. Navy
 3. Marine
 4. Air Force
 5. Coast Guard
 - b. The Fallen will have served and died in combat while in the service of the Armed Forces of the United States of America or its Allies or died as a direct result of injuries (including PTSD related suicide) sustained during this same combat service, and having occurred on or after September 11, 2001, the Global War on Terrorism.
 - c. Proof of loss will be verified prior to confirmation of reservation at CJH.
